The conference will bring together scholars from various disciplines to discuss findings as well as methodological and conceptual issues associated with educational research. The general aim is to extend the CIDER network to other LERN institutes, universities and research institutions in order to support interdisciplinary cooperation among educational researchers. All doctoral and postdoctoral researchers are invited to participate by presenting their work.

Topics of the event will be related to the following research areas:

- Educational inequality and success against the odds
- Competence development as an educational and social process
- Returns to education

The conference includes the following elements:

1. Keynote Lectures

Prof. Dr. Dave Baker (Penn State University)
Prof. Dr. Rolf Becker (Universität Bern)

2. Paper Sessions, where individual papers can be presented for 15 minutes and discussed with other researchers of the field.

3. Poster Session, where research projects, preliminary findings, and datasets relevant to educational research can be presented.

4. Round-Table Presentations, where work in progress as well as controversial issues in the field of educational research can be presented and discussed with other researchers.

5. Panel Discussion on effects of societal crises and challenges (e.g. Covid-19 or refugee crisis) on educational research, with an input presentation by Anna Vignoles (University of Cambridge), and subsequent discussion with educational researchers from different fields.
